

CYP MENTAL HEALTH DATA DASHBOARD

Overview: In a similar way to critical care operational delivery networks asking trusts to log data on HDU patients, the South West Mental Health network is looking to link this habit to looking at MH admissions on the acute wards. Bed occupancy, impact on staffing, diagnosis and baseline on admission, NG tube feeding etc.

Sharing this information will create greater understanding of what is happening, show areas of good practice and allow learning and development.

Objectives:

This answers 3 problems:

1. Outcomes for MH admission and what is happening on the long stays (currently no outcome measures taken)
2. Measuring the impact on staff who are facing “moral injury”
3. Map risk within the system

Evidence: Proof of concept ran for 3 months in 2024 as part of a study on MH admissions to acute wards in England. 82% daily completion rate was achieved showing this is possible, and there is now 12 months of data from 4 acute ICB trusts
